

BCRSGF will be hosting an introduction to judging and judging Special Olympics course

The aim of the course is to review the current FIG judging rules with emphasis on judging execution. It is a course suitable for those wishing to judge at the club level and for those coaches wishing to understand how judges arrive at the scores. Marta judged at the last National Special Olympic Games and has valuable insight into where BC gymnasts can improve and build on their current skills.

For those who are wishing to judge at the provincial level it will be a good review for the upcoming BCRSGF course to be held in Vancouver December 6 and 7.
